Are you looking to further your career and gain your Automotive Refrigerant Handling Licence?

To comply with regulations, you must hold a National Handling License issued by the Australian Refrigeration Council (ARCTICK) in order to work on air-conditioning units or under a holder of a Trading Authorisation. Designed for existing automotive tradespeople, this course teaches you to comply with the Ozone Protection and Synthetic Greenhouse Gas Legislation, enabling you to inspect, service, test, diagnose and repair automotive air-conditioning systems safely.

Held by the IAME this certificate is gained by a process of Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) and classroom revision. RPL or Recognition of Current Competency (RCC), is an assessment pathway you can utilise to recognise the skills, knowledge and experience previously gained through work experience, life experience, training courses and work based training. ARCTICK require each participant to apply for a Training License. You will be provided with instructions upon making a booking for enrolment. Upon successful completion technicians will gain the correct accreditation to be eligible to apply for a restricted Refrigerant Handling Licence.

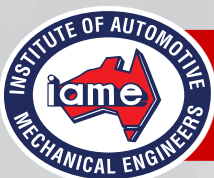
